

- Features 2 doors with ¼" fluted glass inlay, surrounded by solid wood frames.
- Soft close doors, magnetic closures, recessed finger pulls and adjustable hinge hardware.
- Doors reveal 2 storage compartments, each with 2 adjustable shelves for efficient storage space.
- Vertical center brace for additional stability.
- Vitrine is finished in Rubio<sup>®</sup> Monocoat a durable, matte, oil-based protector designed to highlight the beauty of natural wood.
- Wood finish is certified 0% VOC and is an all-natural, environmentally friendly product.

- Power-coated black steel legs.
- Non-marking leveler feet can be adjusted for stability on uneven floor surfaces.
- Assembles easily with provided hardware. Anti-tipping hardware provided.

- It is normal for solid wood to expand and shrink as a result of variations in environmental humidity. A consistent humidity level of approximately 50% is recommended to prevent cracks and surface splits.
